The CCLTOA ETC Committee wishes to Thank the CCLTOA Board for the November vote which approved the New ETC Committee Charter and their 2018 \$5,000 Budget.

Review and discussion on Trail Sign Templates. Need to provide, for Board Approval, a written estimate from Lewis Signs for approximately 100 total metal CCLTOA Trail signs, about \$2,000, before placing the order. Poles and materials/Aaron has some existing inventory.

The Committee wants to Thank all Members who annually clear their Trail Easements for Beautification/Fire Abatement/ Weed Control or other reasons, it is appreciated by the whole Community! The Committee has specific concerns with impediments to effective navigation on existing trails, and discussed the most urgent. These are Compliance/Violation/Repair Trail Issues that need review by the CCLTOA Board and some action taken to remedy: General Notes Here/For Specifics and exact Locations; Contact Committee Chair; 1) Brave Road -Culvert/ Needs Re-enforcing 2) Yolo Ct. – Trash Concern 3) Inyo Ct. – Easement Concern/Trail Impediment 4) Choctaw – Ashlee/Oak Trees Blocking (ETC Volunteer to clear) 5) Canoe St. – Wire/Trash on Easement 6) Cheyenne – Fence blocking Trail.

Discussed the safe travel of horses going with traffic, and the 20 feet of utility easement along edges of roads, that can be utilized when necessary. Also discussed safety concerns when a Trail intersects roads, and what could be done to alert cars that horses may be accessing the road from trails.

Horse Arena Sand Placement, delayed until late spring. Grading needed for drainage. Suggest Aaron get a bid from Jim Wilson to prep area and move sand after delivery.

Spring Event, Tentative Date Sat. May 5, 2018 was discussed. This will be a fun community event for all ages to introduce area residents to the benefits and opportunities for all community members to support a healthy Equestrian Community.
